CULTURAL EDUCATION ANNOUNCES DEBUT CULTURAL PROGRAM OF THE ARTS

ST. CROIX, USVI – The Division of Virgin Islands Cultural Education (DVICE) announces the debut of its Virgin Islands Cultural Program of the Arts, a visual arts program for junior high and high school students.

“The Art program will consist of visual arts, to include drawing, painting and some other art forms such as tie-dying for example,” said DVICE Director Valrica Bryson. “This program is specifically geared towards those students who may love to draw but have not had an opportunity to take an Art course in school.”

The program will begin on February 14 through May 9, 2019, Thursdays and Fridays from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the St. Croix Cultural Arts Center located in Christiansted; adjacent to the Department of Education’s school lunch warehouse.

Fifteen students will be chosen for the program. Interested students must not currently be enrolled in an Art course.

The program will be facilitated by local artists John Jones and Waldemar Brodhurst, and will culminate with an art show in May.

A meeting will be held on Friday, February 8, at 5:30 p.m. in the St. Croix Educational Complex High School’s band room for parents of interested students.
